

CAMPSITE NEWSLETTER

Welcome to the Formula 1 2019 Rolex British Grand Prix!

Please be aware that there may be ticket touts operating in the area. Many of the tickets offered are forged or have been illegally obtained. Please note that you will not be permitted entry to the event if you have purchased a ticket from an unofficial source.

1. Admission to the campsite is limited to the persons and vehicles with passes that have been issued by the campsite owner.
2. The owners of the campsites aim to provide safe and satisfactory facilities for all users of its campsites. THE OWNERS DO NOT ACCEPT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE OR INJURY TO PERSONS OR VEHICLES HOWSOEVER CAUSED EXCEPT IN THE CASE OF PERSONAL INJURY OR DEATH CAUSED THROUGH NEGLIGENCE OF THE OWNERS OR THEIR EMPLOYEES.
3. You are required to comply with any regulations issued by the campsite owners. In particular, neither you nor any member of your party is to commit any nuisance nor to behave in such a way so as to disturb the owners or any other users of the campsite.
4. All drivers and their vehicles must hold a current insurance policy to the minimum requirement of the Road Traffic Acts, Vehicles must, where applicable, be fully licensed. ROAD TRAFFIC ACT TRAFFIC OFFENCES APPLY ON PRIVATE PROPERTY.
5. IN THE EVENT OF ANY BREACH OF THESE CONDITIONS THE OWNERS OF THE CAMPSITE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ADMISSION OR RE-ADMISSION TO THE CAMPSITE. YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO IMMEDIATELY TAKE ALL VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT WITH YOU. In any such instance no refund of any fees paid in advance shall be made and all monies due to the campsite owners shall be paid forthwith.

CAMPSITE SAFETY

COUNTER TERRORISM

There is a serious and sustained threat from both international and Irish-related terrorism to the UK and UK interests overseas. You can check the current threat level on gov.uk

If you suspect suspicious activity, report it to a member of staff or security, or if they are not available dial **999**. (Do not use your mobile phone in the immediate vicinity)

Remember—if you think it's suspicious, SAY SOMETHING.

Firearms and Weapons attacks are rare in the UK. The 'STAY SAFE' principles tell you some simple actions to consider at an incident.

ACTION IN CASE OF FIRE

1. Evacuate the area immediately. Dial **999** and state your location. Contact the campsite operator immediately.
2. Fight fire using equipment and water at nearest fire point if it is safe to do so.
3. If you hear a fire alarm—evacuate your tent or caravan and only assist firefighting if it is safe to do so.

SAFETY AND SECURITY

Car crime prevention advice:

- Don't leave any property on display. What is not valuable to you, may be valuable to someone else.
- Think—Remove it, Lock it, and keep it.
- Make sure you close your windows and lock your car, put your alarm on and use any visible security device, like a steering wheel lock.

TENT SECURITY

- Please ensure you do not leave your valuables in your tent whilst it is unattended.
- Leave your tent untidy, don't make it easy for a thief to grab a bag with everything in it.
- Hide valuables close to you while you sleep.

PERSONAL SAFETY.

- Don't take more money than you need, there are cash points on site or you can pay for items on your card.
- While walking around Silverstone, try and stay with friends, especially at night—there really is safety in numbers!
- Stick to walking in well-lit areas where possible.
- Be aware of your surroundings and avoid wandering around with headphones in.
- Don't challenge people looking through tents—report them to a staff member or the police.
- By all means have a good time, but remember drinking too much hampers your judgment. Make sure you know how to get back to your tent and be aware that you can become prone to assault or robbery when drunk.

SILVERSTONE CIRCUIT SAFETY INFORMATION

ALCOHOL

- Northamptonshire Police will be conducting alcohol test purchasing operations throughout the weekend at the circuit and surrounding licensed premises.
- Underage drinking can lead to young people becoming involved in crime, either as an offender or a victim.
- Northamptonshire Police takes underage drinking particularly seriously and will monitor and respond to any breaches of license efficiently.
- If young people are found to be drinking alcohol in public places they should expect to have the alcohol confiscated and their parents contacted.
- Principles of "Challenge 25" will be enforced to ensure alcohol sales are not made to under 18s.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

The following items are not permitted into the Venue:

Glass bottles (Also not permitted into the campsites) / BBQ's / Restricted and illegal substances / Offensive weapons / No Animals (excluding Assistance Dogs) will be admitted to the Venue or any car parks. All registered assistance dogs we welcome. However, before your arrival please contact the circuit on 0844 3728 251 (Mon-Fri 08.30am–5.30pm only) so that the necessary arrangements can be made / Items that are deemed dangerous, offensive or unsuitable / Drones or remote controlled aircraft / Step ladders / Lasers / Fireworks/Pyrotechnics / Smoke Canisters - Maximum of 1 x 20 litre rucksack per person with luggage tag

SILVERSTONE'S TOP SECURITY TIPS

- Arrive early and leave plenty of time for searches
- Do not leave any of your belongings unattended
- We have a diverse range of food outlets on site so treat yourself to lunch to help keep your bag sizes down
- Please see the prohibited items list to ensure you do not bring any restricted items
- If you see or suspect anything suspicious then contact a staff member, or 999 if urgent.

TRAFFIC ADVICE

- Motorists should allow plenty of time for their journey to and from the event.
- Congestion is likely to start as early as Thursday
- Motorists should be aware of road signs and diversions when travelling to the event and follow the signs that have been put in place
- Race-goers are advised to tune into Silverstone Radio (87.7FM) for the latest updates of crime prevention and traffic information.
- Make sure you close your windows and lock your car, put your alarm on and use any visible security device e.g. a steering wheel lock.

EXITING TRAFFIC

Silverstone has made a significant investment in traffic management for the BGP weekend. However, as with any other large event, there may be some delays in exiting the car parks at peak times. Why not stay and enjoy the entertainment and make the most of your day?

- When leaving car parks, traffic will merge at certain points. To help the flow from each car park please give way to one vehicle from the other lane.
- Extensive use is made of one way systems to help improve the flow of exiting traffic. When used, the one way roads are clearly marked and you should make full use of both lanes when asked to do so.
- Advance warning of one way routes will be given via signs as you leave the circuit. Traffic will be split into the following destinations:
The North—A5, M1 and Northampton. Use this for A43 and East.
The West—A43, M40 and Oxford. Use this for A34 and South West.
The South—A5, M1 and Milton Keynes.
- Please make sure that you know your exit direction—you will not be able to change once you are in the one way system.
- If you are attending on more than one day, please be aware the traffic systems are not the same for each day.

Any items which are considered illegal or offensive will be confiscated. Persons suspected of carrying out illegal or offensive activities onsite may be searched. If caught you will be removed from the premises, and refused re-admission.

SHOPS, PUBS AND RESTAURANTS

Distance from Circuit: 15 minutes walking or 5 minutes driving

Location: A43 North on the Left
Distance from Circuit: 10 minutes driving

THE WHITE HORSE PUB

Location: Silverstone Village
Distance from Circuit: 15 minutes walking or 5 minutes driving
(Please be aware there is a large garden but limited parking. Please do not obstruct footpaths, verges or park at junctions, your vehicle may be towed)

THE GREEN MAN PUB

Location: South towards Brackley
Distance from Circuit: 1 mile

THE FOX & HOUNDS PUB

Location: Whittlebury Village
Distance from Circuit: 1.5 miles from the circuit and a short walk from Whittlebury Campsite.

NEW INN PUB

Location: Abthorpe Village
Distance from Circuit: 2 miles

THE QUEENS HEAD

Location: Chackmore
Distance from Circuit: 2 miles
