FIRE - ACTION / SAFETY:



1. Raise the alarm in the most appropriate way. <u>HONK YOUR HORN CONTINUOUSLY, SHOUT FIRE, FIRE & RING FIRE BELLS</u>. Immediately call the fire service by dialling 999. EVACUATE the area contact the site office and report the fire on 07802 831777 and 07710 629495

2. Tackle the fire using the fire fighting equipment provided <u>only</u> if it is safe to do so (BIG BUCKETS OF WATER & SCOOPS PROVIDED AROUND CAMPSITE)



3. If you hear the fire alarm **EVACUATE** your unit/tent/caravan/ area immediately and assemble in a safe area. (ie Middle Of Field Where NO Campers) DO NOT block access for site staff or emergency vehicles or stop to gather belongings



4. DO NOT light any open fires. All open fires of any kind are strictly prohibited.



5. DO NOT use fireworks. Fireworks & incendiary devices of any kind are strictly prohibited. The police will be called to deal with any person found in possession of such items and you will be removed from the site immediately with no refund

POLICE SECURITY & CRIME PREVENTION

- TAKE money, credit cards, mobile phones, cameras, etc with you at all times. Don't assume that you've hidden them well in your tent. Silverstone has a very good safety history however; large events do attract criminals who steal from tents and cars.
- Mark your property with your name and postcode only, thieves don't want marked property and it will significantly reduce the risk of items being stolen. Tag your keys with your phone number and a friend's address. Marking them means they can be returned to you.
- Leave your tent untidy; don't make it easy for thieves to grab a bag with everything in it.
- Secure the two zip pulls together with a padlock or specialist tent lock **especially** when asleep.
- Use a tent liner as it makes it harder for a thief to get in
- Before you sleep, hide your money, etc carefully and don't put everything together in one place. Remove wallets from clothing. Too much drink can make you sleep heavily and you may not hear somebody unzipping/entering your tent.
- If you think you've had an item stolen, please go to the Mobile Police Station located by Gate 3 at the Silverstone circuit to report the loss and check if it has been handed in.
- Please drink responsibly. Remember excessive alcohol consumption can lead to you being involved in crime as an offender or more importantly as a victim.
- Never drink & drive. **POLICE NON EMERGENCY NUMBER Phone 101**
- Remember it is an offence to purchase alcohol for the consumption of a person under the age of 18
- Please take care when **walking from the site to the circuit** and other venues **especially** when it is dark country roads are not well lit and have uneven grass verges.

COVID ETC

- WEAR your Camping Wristbands and DISPLAY Camping Vehicle Pass at all times.
- REMEMBER HANDS FACE SPACE Use the hand sanitiser! Wash your hands regularly.
- If you have on board facilities you **SHOULD** use them to reduce social mixing.
- Face Coverings: Should be worn inside Toilets and Showers and Hair Drying etc
- Social Distance: 2m when queuing. Please form orderly queues and adhere to one way systems

- Please Reduce the number and length of your showers return to your tent as soon as you can
- **Don't** Shower at Peak Times Get up Early or Shower in the Day or Overnight. The less people mix the better
- **Note** if you don't social distance and minimise household mixing we <u>reserve the right to close the shower facilities</u> completely or at peak times to minimise risk
- Please be patient with Stewards and other Campers. We need to work together for the benefit of all!
- Unless you are LEAVING Site Completely. ALL VEHICLES MUST BE REMAINED PARKED BY YOUR PITCH
 BUT ABOVE ALL PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU ENJOY YOUR STAY AND VISIT TO SILVERSTONE

Local Rules:

STRICTLY NO DOGS OR PETS YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE No Fireworks, Lanterns, Open Fires or Mini Motor Bikes

WHEN CHOOSING A PITCH PLEASE **AVOID <u>FENCED</u> AREAS**. **PITCH SENSIBLY – KEEP 6M APART** CONSIDER **VEHICLE MOVEMENTS** & **FIRE RISK** OF BEING TOO NEAR OTHER CAMPERS –

LOTS OF SPACE! KEEP 15 M FROM OVERHEAD POWER LINES
TREES CAN DROP BRANCHES DO NOT CAMP UNDER THEM

PLEASE TAKE YOUR RUBBISH HOME. NO DRONES, FLARES or LAZER PENS OR PLACE IN SKIP NEAR SHOWERS OR RUBBISH POINTS. BIN LINERS AVAILABLE – JUST ASK.

WHEN LEAVING ON FOOT USE GATE IN CORNER OF FIELD NEAREST CIRCUIT (opposite end to where you drove in (See above ★) Don't walk on the main road, keep to verge)
