

# FORMULA 1 BRITISH GRAND PRIX LOCAL RESIDENTS INFORMATION 4th-7th JULY 2024



The Inter Agency Group are working together to create a safe and secure event for our visitors and our local communities.

## KEY INFORMATION

- **NEW FOR 2024 – Saturday and Sunday PM ONLY access in to Silverstone village via Abthorpe Crossroads will be CLOSED to all traffic INCLUDING LOCAL RESIDENTS from 14.00 – 23.00 (will reopen earlier if possible). Alternative route is via Whittlebury. Exiting traffic unaffected.**
- Parking restrictions will be in force from Friday 5th – Sunday 7th July – see map for further details.
- 30 minutes in four hours limit for short-term on-street parking in layby outside Crofts Stores.
- Footpath and bridleway closures will be in place – local residents will be allowed through for access, leisure, dog-walking.
- Live music entertainment at the circuit will be each night, Thursday – Sunday, with concerts finishing no later than 23.00 (Mahiki Club until 01.00).
- Pyrotechnics finale on Thursday, 22.45 – 22.50 and Sunday post-race, approx. 17.00 – 17.05 (subject to change)

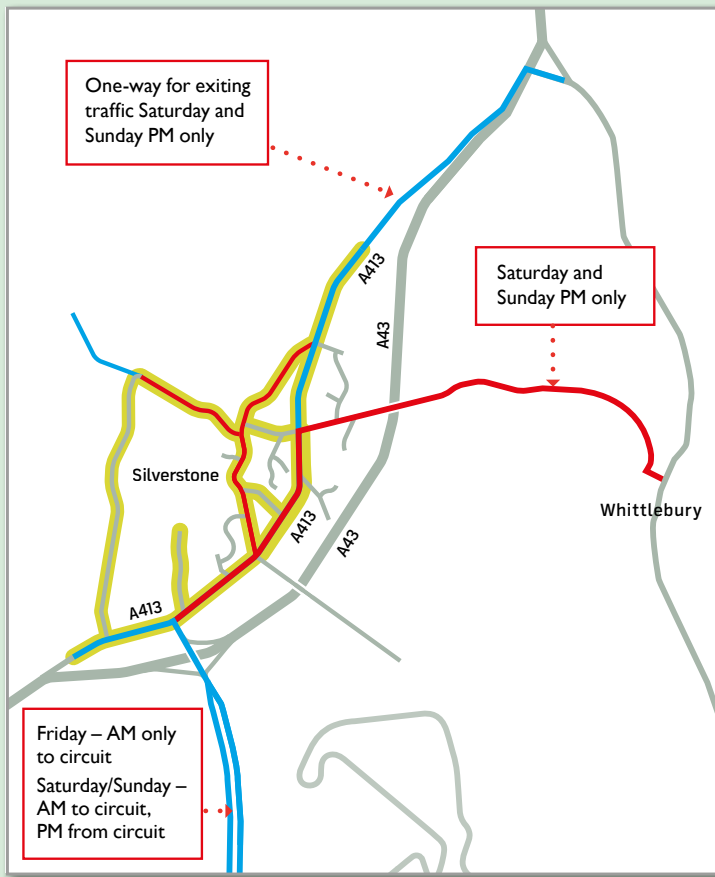
## PARKING RESTRICTIONS

- Parking restrictions will be in place in Silverstone, Whittlebury and Dadford. The map overleaf shows all roads with restrictions.
- Advance warning messages at entrances to villages will advise of parking restrictions in the area.
- Roads affected will have cones and restrictions will be operational 24 hours a day from Friday 5th July 00.01 to Sunday 7th July 23.59.
- Blue badge holder residents without off street parking have been provided with a parking restriction exempt space close to their property.
- Parking restrictions are in place to facilitate emergency access on major roads and residential roads included are to prevent issues with resident access.
- A 30 minutes, no return within four hours, parking restriction will operate in the layby outside Crofts stores for customers, deliveries and postal workers from Friday – Sunday.
- **Enforcement officers provided by West Northamptonshire Council will be in the locality during the operational period. Both residents and visitors may receive penalty notices if parked in coned roads.**

## RESIDENTS ACCESS

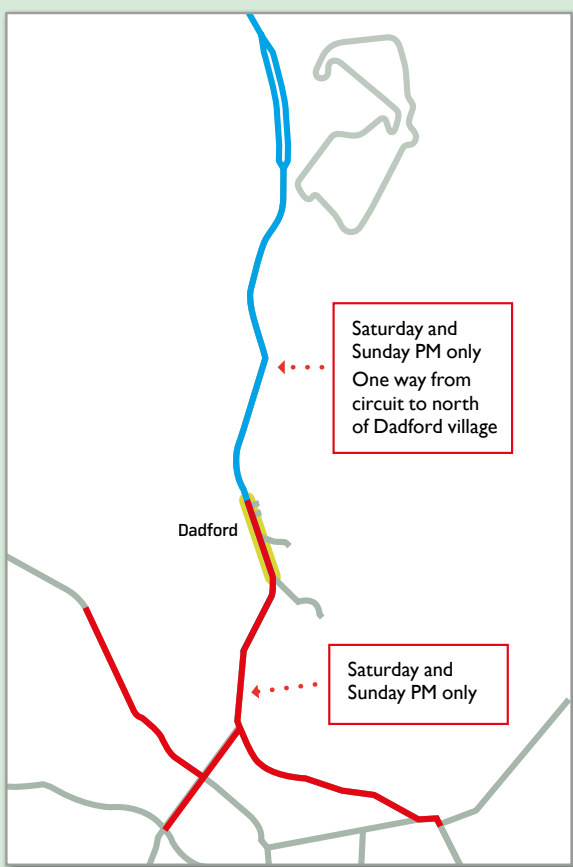
- Labels provided to village residents are to facilitate access through through manned road closures where possible.
- Labels do not allow parking in any coned parking restricted location, they are only to aid access to and from the villages.
- Stewards will not be able to provide access across closed roads unless it is safe to do so; please bear with them during busy periods.
- When one-way systems are in force residents will need to follow the flow of traffic.
- **NEW FOR 2024 There is no access for residents to Silverstone village via Abthorpe crossroads from 14.00 – 23.00 (will reopen earlier if possible) on Saturday 6th July and Sunday 7th July, alternative route is via Whittlebury.**
- Please retain Residents Access labels for use during MotoGP British Grand Prix, 2nd to 4th August.

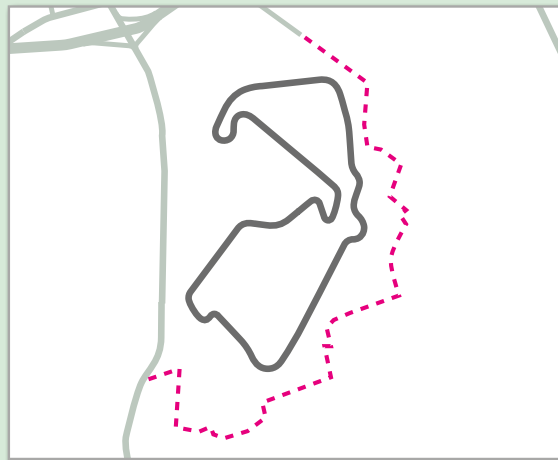
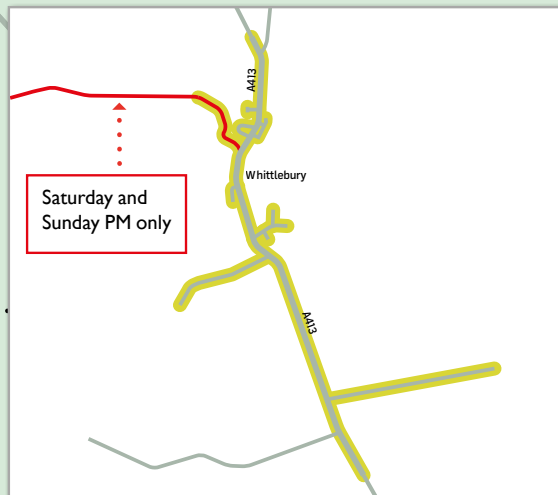

## FOOTPATH & BRIDLEWAY CLOSURES

Closed from Thursday 4th July – Sunday 7th July

- Closures are limited to those necessary for the safety and security of the event.
- Security and Stewards are briefed to allow residents carrying Resident Access labels to access footpaths and bridleways for leisure and dog-walking. The section through Woodlands campsite is managed by the campsite owners, a full closure of this section is in place from Wednesday 3rd July – Monday 8th July.

## WALKING ROUTE TO/FROM CIRCUIT AND SILVERSTONE VILLAGE

The preferred route for pedestrians from village campsites, car parks and accommodation is via Winterhills.

## TAXIS & PRIVATE HIRE VEHICLES

Taxi and private hire vehicle operators have been advised that drop off and pick up locations are at local train stations (Banbury, Milton Keynes, Northampton) with shuttle buses to/from the circuit at these locations.

## NOISE MONITORING

Circuit evening concerts will operate within statutory noise regulations.

A full noise monitoring programme for the British Grand Prix track and entertainment noise will be in operation to monitor both on site and off site noise levels throughout the event.

Sounds checks will take place from Wednesday 3rd July.

A noise complaints procedure will be in place for the event, further details are available on the Residents British Grand Prix information page of the circuit website.

## POLICING

A significant crime prevention operation will take place throughout the event. The community policing presence within surrounding villages will be increased for 2024.
